CommuteSmart Central NH Emergency Ride Home Program Rules

Worried that you'll get stuck somewhere without a ride? CommuteSmart Central NH offers an Emergency Ride Home program to ensure access to transportation in case of an emergency.

Who is eligible?

- To be eligible for an emergency ride home, you must be registered within the NH Rideshare Portal **AND** live or work within the communities of Allenstown, Boscawen, Bow, Bradford, Canterbury, Chichester, Concord, Deering, Dunbarton, Epsom, Henniker, Hillsborough, Hopkinton, Loudon, Pembroke, Pittsfield, Salisbury, Sutton, Warner, and Webster.

What are qualified emergencies?

Qualified Emergencies:

- Unexpected personal or family illness or emergency
- Carpool driver has illness, emergency, or unscheduled overtime
- You work unscheduled overtime
- Weather related events (Bicyclist & Walkers only)

NOT Included as an Emergency:

- Personal errands
- Business-related travel
- Pre-planned appointments
- Scheduled overtime at work
- Transportation system delays
- General rides to work
- On-the job injury
- Vehicle failure

What are eligible destinations?

- Home
- Park and Ride lot where car is parked
- Child's day care or school
- Medical facility
- Interim stops if part of the emergency

Emergency Ride Home Trip Allowances?

- You may submit up to six (6) requests per 12 month period, no more than two (2) in any month, for a maximum reimbursement of \$70 per occurrence.
